Area :	5,5 hectares (among the 15 hectares of the vineyard)
Terroir :	Sandy-clay soil on ferrous blue clay veins
Grape varieties :	95% Merlot ; 5% Cabernet Franc
Average age of the vine :	25 years
Cultivation technique :	No herbicides, tillage, cover crops, disbudding, leaf stripping, thinning...
Harvest :	By hand from 23 rd September to 2 nd October.
Yield :	38,01 hl / ha
Winemaking :	In temperature-controlled concrete vats. Alcoholic fermentation and maceration during 15 to 20 days.
Ageing :	In concrete vats.
Bottling :	21 st April 2020
Production :	15 680 bottles / 1 252 magnums
